Itinerary

Day 01 Arrive Beijing

Upon arrival in Beijing, you will be met and transferred to hotel. Beijing, has been the capital of China for better part of 900 years and is now once again the cultural and political centre of the People's Republic. Its magnificent buildings and vast museum are testimonials to centuries of Chinese art and culture, as well as symbols of the country's modern progress.



Day 02 Beijing

(B/L)

No tour of Beijing would be complete without a visit to the Great Wall of China, built to keep the northern 'barbarians' away. Chinese lunch will be served at local restaurant. This will be combined with a tour of the Ming Tomb, burial place of 13 out of 16 Ming Emperors.

Day 03 Beijing

(B/L/D)

Tour highlights include a visit to the Tiananmen Square which is the world's largest public square with several important monuments and buildings such as the Great Hall of the People and the Memorial hall of Chairman Mao. Then proceed to the Forbidden City, also know as the Imperial Palace – the home of the emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasty. After lunch, continue to explore the Summer Palace, the former resort of the Qin visit the Temple of Heaven where the emperors used to pray for plentiful harvests.

This evening, enjoy an authentic Beijing Duck banquet.



Day 04 Beijing / Xian

(B/D)

Depart for Xian by flight, the capital of 11 Dynasties. Xian was called Chan An in ancient times, with a history of more than 3,000 years.

Evening, enjoy dumpling dinner at local restaurant

Day 05 Xian

(B/L/D)

Full day sightseeing includes a visit the excavation of the life-sized Terra-Cotta Warriors and Horses. Continue to visit the sites of great archaeological and architectural interest – the remains of Ban Po. Then proceed to visit Huaqing Hot Spring and Big Wild Goose Pagoda.

This evening, enjoy a dinner with show at the Tang Dynasty Restaurant.

Day 06 Xian / Guilin

(B/L/D)

Depart for Guilin. Guilin, named after the osmanthus, built in Qin Dynasty, prospering in Tang and Song, flourishing in Ming and Qing, is a well-known scenic tourist city, cultural and historic city in the world. Located in the subtropical region, Guilin boasts of a pleasant climate suitable for sightseeing throughout the four seasons.



- Day 07 Guilin (B/L)
A full day cruise along the Li River offers a scene of exotic beauty with towering cliffs on both sides with a stop off at the picturesque hamlet of Yangshuo with Chinese lunch onboard.
Return to Guilin by coach.
- Day 8 Guilin / Shanghai (B/L)
Visit the Elephant Trunk Hill, Fubo Hill for a panoramic view of Guilin and the Reed Flute Cave which is filled with dramatic stalactite and stalagmite formation with Chinese lunch will be served at local restaurant. Transfer to airport for flight. to Shanghai.
Upon arrival, met and transferred to hotel. Shanghai, is a gateway to the fertile Yangtze River valley, the dynamic centre of China's trade and industry.
- Day 9 Shanghai (B)
